DEAN OF STUDENTS

The Dean of Students (Jeffries Hall, first floor) serves as an advocate for the GCU student, ensuring that the student voice is heard. As a key liaison between the students and university administration, the dean of students works to develop open lines of communication and a healthy collegial environment among students and the administrative staff. Serving as the chief judicial officer as it relates to student issues, the dean of students also develops and facilitates the Student Code of Conduct, the Sexual and Gender-Based Misconduct Policy, and other policies and procedures that govern student conduct. The Dean of Students is also the chief student affairs officer at GCU managing the following offices: Residence Life, Student Life, and Student Activities and Engagement. The Division of Student Affairs creates a campus environment where the GCU student is fully engaged both inside and outside of the classroom.

The dean also serves as a Title IX coordinator.
