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SCHOOL SUPERVISOR, POST-MASTER'S ENDORSEMENT PROGRAM

School supervisors are key school or district professionals who work with instructional personnel on issues of curriculum, instruction, and the development of the instructional staff. Individuals with this endorsement may also be appointed as an assistant superintendent with responsibilities for curriculum and/or instruction. The program's focus is the development of 21st-century curricular leadership skills for the inclusive school and district. The program is aligned with the New Jersey Professional Standards for Educational Leaders. It also addresses issues in inclusive education and the New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS). Upon completion of this program, candidates will qualify for a Certificate of Eligibility for New Jersey administrative certification as a School Supervisor.

Applicants to this post-master's certificate program must have a master's degree in education from an accredited four-year institution, possess a valid New Jersey instructional certificate, and have three years of successful teaching or educational services experience.
